WHAT'S NEW AND WHAT'S NEXT?

Back in October, we held three workshops in Bismarck, Mandan, and Lincoln to find out the transportation priorities of the community. We asked about transportation goals, performance areas, and emerging issues and asked the public to identify potential transportation network improvements including new and/or widened roads, bridges, railroad grade separations, interchanges, multimodal improvements, and transit corridors.

Using preferences the public provided in October we've been working to understand the impacts different roadway projects and concepts have on the transportation system through 2045. We again are asking for your input to help us identify projects that are a good investment for the transportation system. Using public input we receive in July, we will complete the process of prioritizing projects and policies for the Bismarck-Mandan MPO based on expected revenue through the year 2045. Please join us for one of three planned meetings we have scheduled in the weeks ahead.
